



# Synopsis

The "Creative Art" workshop is a journey in territories where natural processes of morphogenesis tamper in the cultural ecosystem, exploring different ways of generating and representing ideas (as well as the intricate interplay between these two creative conditions) through art concepts applied as an intensive search for spatial conditions in order to configure architectonical spaces.

the workshop is directed to undergraduate students (1st to 3rd year, facolty of Architecture, AIU), with little or no knowledge of digital generative tools. Aim of this course is to give students insights on different ways to generate and represent ideas combining exercises based on art examples and nature processes as paradigms. The goal will be achieved through theoretical classes, personal research and practical sessions.



### Course structure


The workshop consists of three phases; in order to understand the different approaches every phase of the workshop will be complemented with lectures.


. Phase A: is about exploration: students scrutinized general issues of art as paradigms for ideas generation and representation.



#### Course structure

- . Phase B: is about spatial experimentation. In order for the students to introduce the local artistic and cultural movement, guest lecturer Dr.Artist Buthayna Ali did a lecture aspart of the program. After, they were able to create an art installation with spatial conditions in a public space (for instance: Inside AIU).
- . Phase C: is about action in spatial perception and expression. Students filmed a video based on Action art concepts focused into space generation.





## Workshop unroll

The workshop fosters the immediate application and exploration (through trial and error, improvisation and adaption) of the insights given during the lectures. The lecture sequence itself is a path through various aspects of the creative process, in a gradient that encompasses theoretical premises, procedural methods, material application and evaluation of achievements. As the workshop unfolds the density of lecture hours diminishes gradually shifting towards full, tutorized, work.

The final task is the design for a pavilion located in a site (choice is up to each group, via previuos feasibility judgment by the professors) inside the AIU. The work goes by trial and errors from the fast production of concepts, through the refinement of a final proposal in the form of a small scale model. Each of these workshop phases is followed by a pin-up: ideas circulation and sharing creates a more creative environment, enforces and speeds up learning; for these reasons pin-ups are collective, students can take advantage of everyone's discussion and proposals. After the initial convergence on a proposal, projects are refined introducing deeper site negotiation and material logics towards the construction of a large scale model. While exploring issues about material logics, construction, adaptation, students also explore dynamically the body-space interaction created through the pavilions in the form of a video. The produced material is completed by two A1 panels by each group which resume technical and creative aspects (from the generative to the symbolic) of the final projects.

A final presentation with a selected international jury evaluated the students processes and outcomes.




